I would like to bring attention to HR 3967 "Honoring Our Pact Act" that was passed by the House and moving to the US Senate. If this bill was to pass it would bring additional support to several issues, a couple would be to add agent Orange Presumptive Conditions along with adding Thailand, Laos and Cambodia to a list of where exposure to Agent Orange. Please research and find out for yourself about this legislation, you might want to contact your senators and tell them to vote and support this bill.
