

Notes from Todd Rose Veteran Service Officer in Watertown

VA Pension helps Veterans, and their families cope with financial challenges by providing supplemental income through the Veteran Pension and

Survivors Pension benefit programs. Payments are made to bring the Veteran's or Survivor's total income including other retirement or Social Security income to a level set by Congress. Unreimbursement medical expenses may reduce countable income for VA purposes.

First thing is Pension claims take on average a year to process once it has been submitted to the VA. There is a significant amount of responsibility and paperwork needed from the claimant to start the process: all income, assets and reimbursed medical expenses figures along with supporting documentation. This information is needed for both veteran and spouse if married.

Generally, a Veteran must have at least 90 days of active duty service, with at least one day during a VA-recognized wartime period to qualify. The 90 day requirement does not apply if the Veteran was discharged due to service-connected disabilty.

Current maximum total assets allowed is set at \$129,000 to be eligible to apply (this does not included your house and a 2 acre lot it is on, if you have more land than that, that will be considered an asset).

Rule of thumb if the veteran and/or spouse are living only on social Security and they have a fair amount of unreimbursed medical expense (out of pocket) it might be worth asking a few more questions about if eligible to file a claim.

Survivors Pension is a tax-free benefit payable to low income surviving spouses or children who have not married/remarried since the death of the Veteran. Eligibility is based off the Veterans eligibility and follows the same claim requirements.

New Laws to Benefit South Dakota Veterans

Veterans in South Dakota will have access to improved education benefits this year with the passing of House Bill 1069 during the 2020 legislative session.

"Many skills military service members acquire translate well into the technical trades," said Greg Whitlock, Secretary of the the South Dakota Department of Veterans Affairs. "HB 1069 helps veterans continue their education, tuition free, at one of South Dakota's technical colleges.:

Veterans wishing to use this benefit are encouraged to visit with the technical colleges school certifying officials.

Additional law changes include lowering the threshold requirements for disabled veterans participation in special group pheasant hunts from 40% service-connected or higher to 20% service connected and higher.

Also, as part of an ongoing red tape review, the South Dakota Veterans Commission was determined archaic and all statutes pertaining to the Commission were repealed.


VVA Chapter 1054 Sets up Scholarship Fund

Speaker will be Lee Gable,


Lehia Pietz will provide music
