# **Notes from Todd Rose**

(Veterans Service Officer for Codington County)

Veteran's Pension is a "needs based" benefit paid to "wartime veterans" who have limited or no income and net

worth. Spouses or dependents of "wartime veterans" can also be eligible for a pension if the veteran meets the service requirements and the spouse or dependent meet the financial requirements.

Pension claims are not easy or quick, and once filed, can take several months to be finalized. But if you do qualify, it can provide additional financial assistance to a veteran, spouse or dependents. It is designed to help bring someone that is currently living below poverty level back to or just above poverty level.

There are several factors that are used to determine eligibility, too many to try and explain in the newsletter. If you know someone that might be financially challenged and they are a veteran or dependent of a veteran, please have them contact the office so we can see if they might be eligible to apply.

There are "4" basic requirements a veteran must meet to be eligible:

- \* Length of Service/ Character of discharge
- \* Wartime Service
- \* Permanent and total disability (if under age 65)
- Income/Net Worth Qualifications (minus) unreimbursed medical expenses.

Again, this is very basic information to get you thinking if you or someone you know might be eligible for Veteran's pension. Please contact the office or have them contact the office and we will do our best to determine their eligibility. Codington County Veterans Service Office is open Monday-Friday from 0800-1700. Our phone number is **605-882-6289**, and we are located at 125 S Broadway, in the old Watertown City Auditorium.
