Notes from Todd Rose (Veterans Service Officer for Codington County)

As of December 1, 2022 the VA Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) for 2023 is 8.7%. This is the highest COLA increase seen in the last 40 years. Your VA compensation or pension disbursement at the end of the month will reflect the increase. COLA adjustments takes place every December, with that in mind, a quick reminder that VA benefits are non-taxable. If you are receiving retirement pay from your military service that is still taxable.

Another quick reminder that if you are 40% service connected, you are eligible for a reduced hunting and fishing license from the SD Game, Fish and Parks. Remember the annual fishing license expires on 31Jan23.

- * Free medical assessment for possible health problems
- Veterans do not need to be eligible or enrolled in the VA
- * Separate from filing a claim for disablilty benefits.
