old or new benefits might be available.

I want to share some data to show the economic impact veterans and their dependents have on the local area. Every year the VA publishes a Geographic Distribution of VA expenditures, to show where funds are spent for benefits and medical support to the veterans, spouses. and dependents in the county. In 2022, Codington County received \$19,431,000. That was an increase from 2021 of \$3,100,000.

Please complete the VA surveys when you get one. If you were happy and satisfied with the treatment and process received, let someone know. If you were not so happy or something went wrong let them know that. It might not seem like things have changed, but if you don't tell them your thoughts and concerns, the VA cannot address or fix the issue.

We have started to see and hear about an uptick in scams and claim sharks targeting veterans, spouses and dependents. Promising possible VA benefits, they can secure for them by working through them, but be aware of the hidden fees. I would encourage or advise everyone that they have plenty of free options, your local county or tribal VSO, your local veteran's organization or your state veteran's administration to get claim guidance or assistance for free.

One last thing is if you are eligible to file for travel benefits through the VA, as of 1 July 2023, we have been told that you will only have 30 days to complete and submit your travel payment request, after that the VA will not process..

Codington County Veteran Service Office is located at 125 S Broadway (old City Auditorium), Watertown. We are in the office Monday-Friday, 0800-1700. Walk ins are welcomed and appointments are greatly appreciated. Our phone number is 605-882-6289.





Langenfeld's bridge is on Hwy 212 close to Mt. Hope's cemetery, over Willow Creek. Charles served as HM2 Medic and was killed 2 days before he was to return home. His unit had gone 88 days without a bath and was returning when was attached. He was a member of the class of 65.

Did you know......Forrect Mars originally created M & M's in 1941 during WWII. Mars drew inspiration for the candy after observing soldiers consume chocolate pellets enclosed in a protective hard shell during the Spanish Civil War. The idea behind the hard shell was to prevent the chocolate from melting while the soldiers carried the candy in warm tropicial weather. Initially, reserved exclusively for military WWII, M&M's became available to the general public as wartime guotas were lifted.


