Chapter 1054 Helps Veterans in Hawaii, after fire Destroys Homes

Early in December, Bo Mahoe (Sergeant at Arms at the Maui County Veterans Council), Glenn Kamak (from the Maui CBOC) and other Maui Veterans helped us by distributing a \$500 check from VVA 1054 to each of 10 Veterans in the hard-hit area of Honokowai, north of Lahaina. Bo Mahoe emailed us the following:

"Communication with recipients has been a struggle (some had only landlines); many veterans have had to relocate towards temporary housing solutions an average of six (6) times in the last 100 days. (this condo for 5 days; move to this hotel room for 9 days; stay with family 2 weeks etc.). USPS mail delivery has been challenging."

We were able to assist the following Veterans in rebuilding after the disaster: Ronald De Mello, Chelsea Fernandez, Abraham Ah Hee, Butch Soares, Steve Moyer, Calvin Ah Hee, Warren Baybado (100% house loss and 2 cars), Clement Vianueva. Two additional Vets will receive checks shortly.

VVA Bell Ringers for the Salvation Army


