The Vietnam War Commemoration Pin program is coming to an end. You can still go to Congressmen Dusty Johnson's webpage and look under SERVICE, then scroll down to Vietnam Commemoration to complete the form or click on the link below and it should take you directly to the form that needs to be completed to nominate a veteran. If you have additional questions concerning this, please feel free to contact one of the Rep. Johnson's District offices: Rapid City 605-646-6454, Sioux Falls 605-275-2868, Aberdeen 605-622-1060.

For anyone using TRICARE and wanting to make any changes the Open Season start 11Nov-10 Dec 2024. Also, if you are currently paying for TRICARE benefits with an automatic withdrawal from a bank account you should have received a letter from TRICARE to inform you that you will need to update your account withdrawal prior to 1Jan25 or your coverage would end. You can contact TRICARE West Region @West Region TRICARE (https://www.tricare.mil/west) scroll down the page and you will see the options to TRICARE Automatic Payment Authorization Form.

Also, as a reminder during this time of the year if you are a hunter or fisherman and you are 40% service connected or have a "K-Award" you can take your Summary of Benefits letter to the local regional SD GF&P and they can get you a Basic Hunting and Fishing license for \$10 and it is good for 4 years.

Lastly, if you are receiving benefits from the VA, you should have received a Summary of Benefits letter from the VA within the last week or so. This letter will have your service connection % but not have your "K-Award". If you have been awarded the "K-Award" you will need to contact your local VSO to get an updated letter.

The Veteran's Service Officer provides expert claims service to every eligible Codington & Hamlin Veterans and his/her dependants and survivors: to aid the veteran in understanding entitlements, which can minimize the burden of health and economic stress; to process the necessary forms for Federal as well as State Veteran Benefits.

Veteran's Transportation Services

The Veteran's Transportation Services will now offer transportation to the VA in Sioux Falls. Monday-Friday (excluding holidays) from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm you can call 605-977-4400 or email vhasuxvetridetravel@va.gov to set up an appointment. All appointments must be scheduled 3 business days in advanced. Any cancellations must be 2 day in advance. These are for approved VA appointments.

The Watertown Community Transit will provide rides within the city limit for veterans for both VA and non VA appointments. Call 605-882-5287 to request a ride. This must be done 24 hours or more in advance.

Scheduling Procedule
Change

The VA is changing how primary care appointments are scheduled. In the past, primary care encounters included a separate appointment for intake with the nurse to reveiw the medication list, update allergies and past history as well as provide immunizations. Going forward, the nursing visit will be incorporated into the provider time. So, if you have an appointment at 10 am, the first 30 minutes will be with the nurse and you will see the physician around 10:30 am. In the past, patients would have had two separate appointments. Now there will be only one. The laboratory appoint will continue to be separate, and we strongly encourage patients to have lab work done at least a day in advance so that this can be discussed during their appointment.
